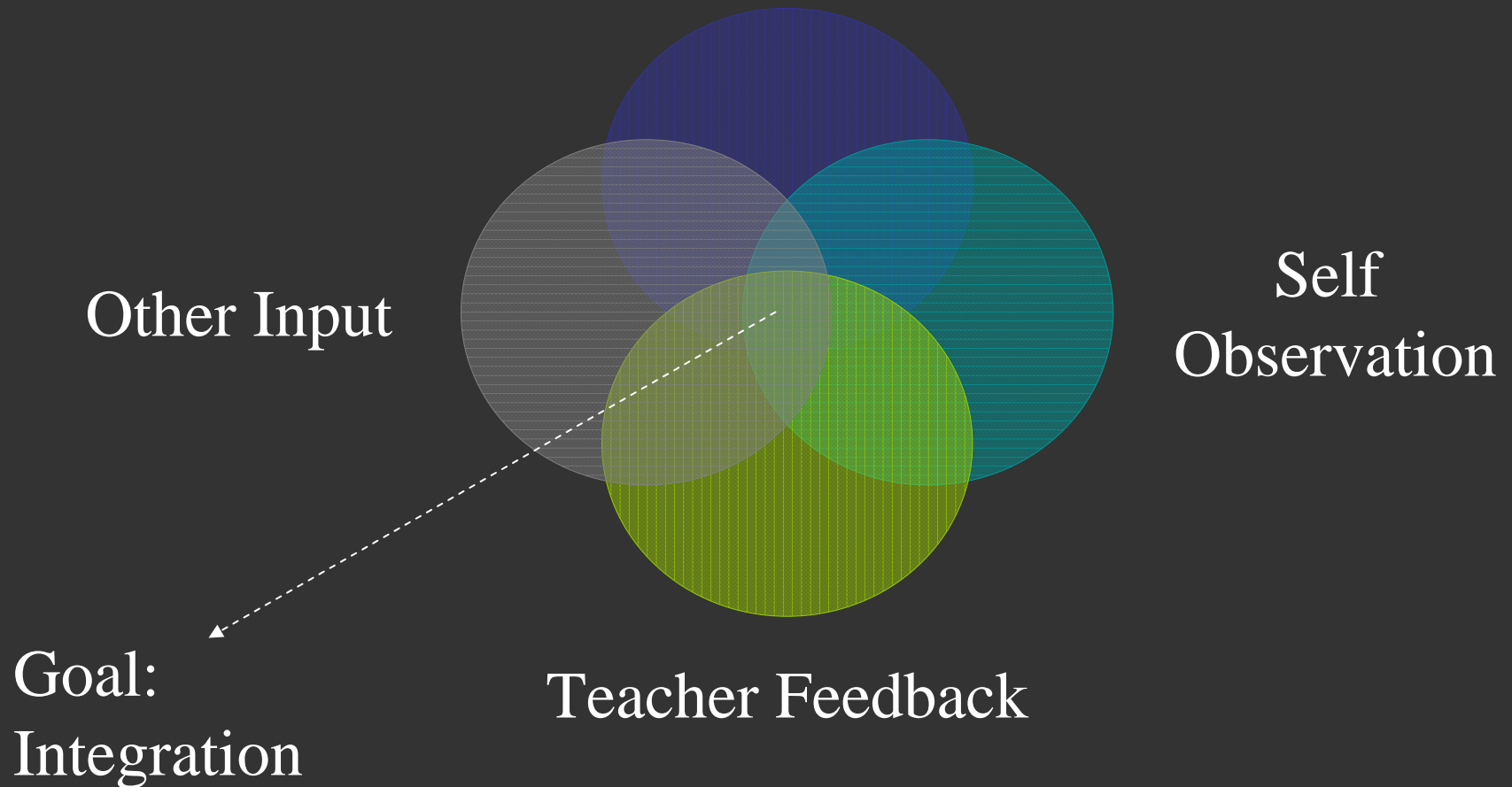


Why Self Observation/Assessment?
